## Blackboard: Beyond just course management

The 90 minute and 60 hands-on minute workshops on Bb will focus on two aspects: firstly, participants will learn how to organize and label course content for easy student access. Secondly, instructors will learn how to develop activities with Bb's assessment and computer-mediated communication tools (Voicboards, Wikis & Blogs) for developing linguistic accuracy and communicative competence. In addition, presenters will show how to use Bb's grade book and integrate learning modules based on cultural topics, literary works and film. *Get ideas for a project that you can use in your next proposal for an SAS Language Teaching Innovation Grant.*
